Can you explain the process of 'staircasing'?









- Full market value in
 2020=£100,000
- A 50% share of this home cost £50,000 in 2020
- Revaluation to buy more shares in 2025 = £120,000
- Remaining 50% share to be purchased in 2025 = £60,000

How easy is it to sell a shared ownership property?







What other costs are there to think about with shared ownership?







Stamp duty example based on market value election:

You pay £140,000 to buy a 50% share of a property with a market value of £280,000. The stamp duty you pay will be calculated as follows:

•0% on the first £125,000 = £0
•2% on the second £125,000 = £2,500
•5% on the final £30,000 = £1,500
•total SDLT = £4,000

* 0% on the first £300,000 * 5% on the remainder up to £500,000








Do you need to have a large deposit?
